Who? Lenape Valley Foundation Mobile Crisis Intervention Services are available to all residents of Bucks County aged 18 years and above experiencing acute issues with disturbed thought, behavior, mood or social relationships that require immediate intervention.

Lenape Valley Foundation Mobile Crisis Intervention Services are provided by experienced Mental Health Professionals with extensive knowledge of behavioral health disorders, treatment and local community resources.

What? Mobile Crisis Intervention Services include:

- assessment
- information and referral to behavioral health treatment and support services
- · crisis counseling, resolution, and follow-up
- · accessing local, individualized community resources
- accessing emergency services and psychiatric or medical consultation

Where? Lenape Valley Foundation Mobile Crisis Intervention Services staff travel in Bucks County to where the person in need of assistance is located. Mobile services more effectively incorporate natural supports and facilitate individualized recommendations and referrals.

When? Mobile Crisis Intervention Services are available Monday through Friday, 9a.m. to 9p.m.

Lenape Valley Foundation will continue to provide site-based walk-in and telephone crisis services on a 24 hour/day basis in central and lower Bucks County.

How? To request Mobile Crisis Intervention Services, call 215-785-9765. A Telephone Crisis Worker will gather preliminary information, help determine if Mobile Services are appropriate, and dispatch a Mobile Crisis Intervention Service team.
