



Free Movie Mondays starting again at Bucks County Community College

NEWTOWN TOWNSHIP — Bucks County Community College is starting its Free Movie Mondays series again.

All showings are at 6:30 p.m. in the Kevin and Sima Zlock Performing Arts Center in the Gateway Center at the BCCC Newtown Township campus, 275 Swamp Road.

The series starts Monday with "Cyber Bully," about a teenager subjected to a bullying campaign by classmates through a social media site.

Co-sponsored by the Council Rock Education Association, the film will be followed by a panel discussion with representatives from the Lenape Valley Foundation and the Network of Victims Assistance. The film's showing coincides with Suicide Awareness Month.

The series continues with:

- "Tickling Giants" on Oct. 9, a documentary about an Egyptian cardiologist who turned to comedy after the Arab Spring;
- "Dakota's Pride" on Oct. 23, about people with Down syndrome;
- "Away from Her" on Nov. 27, about Alzheimer's disease; and
- "The Normal Heart" on Dec. 4, about the AIDS crisis.
