### Lenape Valley Foundation to Host Suicide Prevention Conference

**Doylestown, PA, August 27, 2018** – Lenape Valley Foundation will host a suicide prevention conference on Tuesday, October 9. **Looking to the Future in Suicide Prevention** will be held in the Life Sciences Building Auditorium at Delaware Valley University located at 700 E. Butler Avenue in Doylestown from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. The conference is offered in partnership with Delaware Valley University.

The keynote speaker is Bart Andrews, Ph.D. Dr. Andrews is Vice President of Telehealth & Home/Community Services at Behavioral Health Response. He is the Co-Chair of the Suicide Lifeline's Standards, Training and Practices committee, a member of the Suicide Prevention Resource Center's (SPRC) Steering Committee, a SPRC ZeroSuicide Academy Faculty member and a member of the American Association of Suicidology's Executive Board of Directors. Dr. Andrews is a suicide attempt survivor and a proponent of embracing lived expertise in our suicide prevention efforts.

Registration for the conference begins at 8:30 a.m. and the program runs from 9 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The day will include afternoon breakout sessions. The conference is open to the public, however reservations are required and space is limited. The registration fee is \$20 and includes a continental breakfast and lunch.
