Public Invited to a Showing of the Film Healing Voices

Doylestown, PA, March 27, 2019 – Lenape Valley Foundation's Trauma Informed Care Committee, in partnership with Delaware Valley University, invites the public to a showing of the film *Healing Voices*. The showing will be held on Wednesday, May 29 from 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm in the Life Sciences Building Auditorium at Delaware Valley University, 700 E. Butler Avenue, Doylestown.

Healing Voices explores the experiences commonly labeled as "psychosis" or "mental illness" through the real-life stories of individuals working to overcome extreme mental states and integrate these experiences into their lives in meaningful ways.

There will be a live discussion about mental illness following the film and refreshments will be served. Free parking will be available in Lot C (access off New Britain Road).
