Lenape Valley Foundation Golf Outing Featuring Dick Vermeil as Speaker Raises \$63,000

Doylestown, Pa., September 6, 2019 - Lenape Valley Foundation (LVF) hosted its 10th annual Golf Outing on Monday, August 19, at Doylestown Country Club in Bucks County, Pa.

Former NFL/Philadelphia Eagles coach, Dick Vermeil, served as the event's guest speaker during the evening program. Doylestown Mayor Ron Strouse was the emcee for the evening and Robert Rogala of Doylestown, PA, LVF's Board President, served as the event chairperson.
